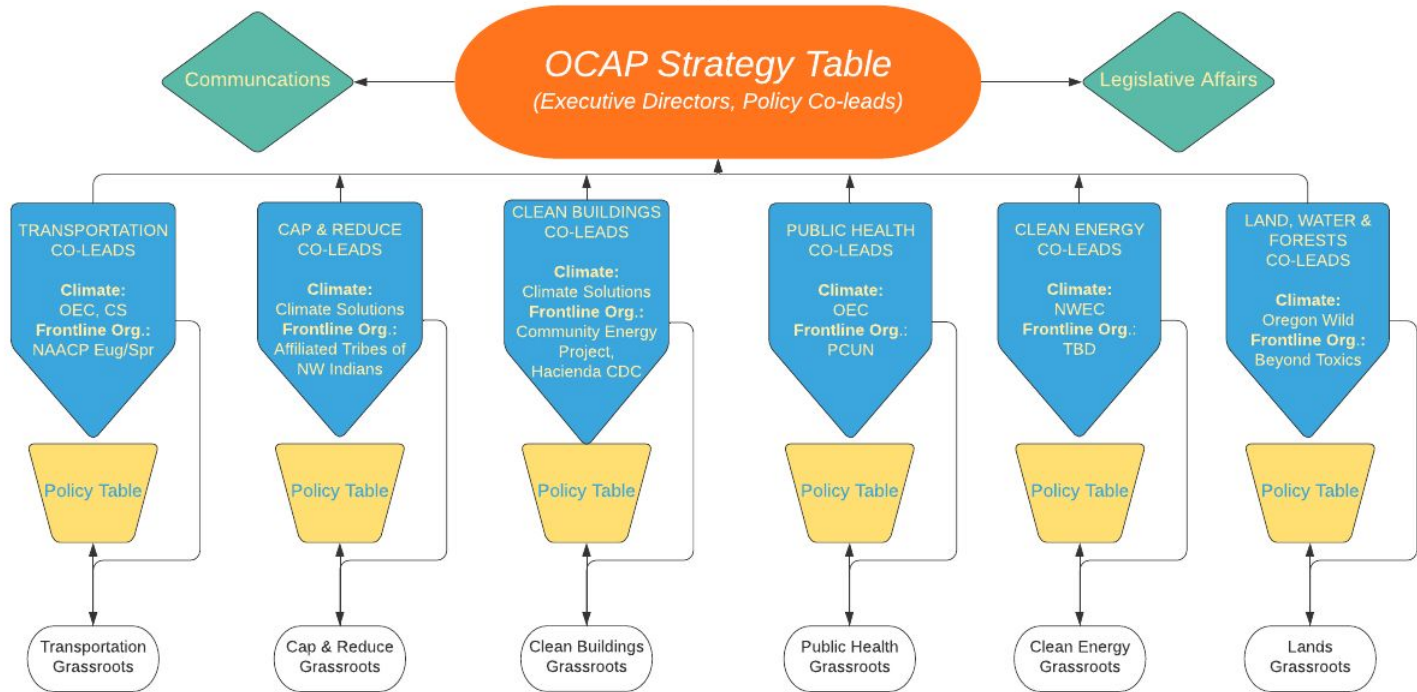


# Oregon Climate Action Plan coalition

## OCAP Strategy Table responsibilities:

- Serve as the decision making strategy table for policy, legislative/legal, communications for OCAP implementation and rulemaking
- Information sharing and cross-issue collaboration
- We will need to work through how to resolve conflicts, how decisions will be made (I would recommend we hire a facilitator to help us with this)
- Legislative agenda and strategy for EO
- Legal strategies

## Main OCAP Listserv responsibilities and best practices:

- Share information about monthly OCAP coalition meetings to receive readouts, ask questions and provide feedback on OCAP coordination table work

- Support broad grassroots engagement efforts around OCAP implementation, including sign-on letters and participating in social media pushes
- Listserv is *not* intended for discussion (there are separate listservs for each of the specific policy areas where that discussion can happen), but rather for sharing opportunities requiring broad coalition engagement, like a sign on letter to the Governor

**Policy table responsibilities:**

- Work through strategy development and policy recommendations for agencies
- Participate in regular calls to discuss agency action items, the strategy around engagement and identify grassroots advocacy needs
- Draft materials to support grassroots engagement on agency actions-- i.e. comment letters, factsheets, talking points, etc.
- Conduct research to inform substantive policy asks/recommendations
- Attend meetings with agency staff as needed

**Grassroots table/listserv responsibilities:**

- Provide input to co-leads on responses for agencies
- Participate in calls as-needed to discuss action items and engagement needs
- Support grassroots engagement efforts around OCAP implementation, including communications needs such as placing LTEs and participating in social media pushes
- Attend public meetings, including Rulemaking Advisory Committee meetings
- Draft/submit public comments

***\*\*\*Policy tables are not fully set as these are initial interests and an incomplete brainstorm of organizations we would ultimately like to have at the table if they have the capacity to join with an intent to keep manageable in size\*\*\****
